The quota place(s) is/are allocated to the NOC by discipline and gender and not by event.

## C. ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

All athletes must comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter currently in force, including Rule 41 (Nationality of Competitors), and only those athletes who have complied with the Olympic Charter may participate in the Winter Youth Olympic Games.

#### C.1. AGE REQUIREMENTS:

To be eligible to participate in the Lausanne 2020 Winter Youth Olympic Games, athletes must have been born between 1 January 2002 and 31 December 2003.

D.3:	D.3. Relays		
	A Single Mixed Relay team is composed of one (1) woman and one (1) man from the same NOC.		
	A Mixed Relay team is composed of two (2) men and two (2) women from the same NOC.		
	An NOC may only enter 1 team per relay event. Participation in the Single Mixed Relay and the Mixed Relay events will be limited to a maximum of 30 relay teams per event.		
	The participation of the 30 teams in each relay event will be granted according to the following order of priority:		
	<ol> <li>NOCs which have earned both male and female quotas through D.1 or D. will be able to enter 1 team per relay event until the maximum quota of 30 teams is filled.</li> </ol>		
	<ol> <li>In the event that there are remaining quota places thereafter, NOCs who have earned quotas through D.1 or D.2 in one (1) gender and through reallocation in the other gender will be able to enter 1 team per relay ever until the maximum quota of 30 teams is filled.</li> </ol>	nt	
	<ol> <li>In the event that there are still remaining quota places thereafter, NOCs we have earned both male and female quotas through reallocation will be able to enter 1 team per relay event until the maximum quota of 30 teams is filled.</li> </ol>		
	If there is a tie for the final (30th) allocated quota place(s), the NOCs with the highest cumulated scores from the Junior Men and Junior Women Nation Cup rankings will be entitled to enter a team until the maximum quota of 30 teams is filled.		

#### **HOST COUNTRY PLACES**

If the Host Country does not qualify any athletes through D.1 or D.2, it is guaranteed three (3) quota place per gender and has to confirm by 12 April 2019 to IBU.

# E. CONFIRMATION PROCESS FOR QUOTA PLACES

IBU will publish the final IBU World Cup Nation Cup Score and final IBU Junior Cup Nation Cup Score immediately after the last event of the season by 30 March 2019, on www.biathlonworld.com and inform the respective NOCs of their allocated quota places. The NOCs will then have to confirm if they wish to use these quota places to IBU and Lausanne 2020 Sport Entries, as detailed in paragraph **G. Qualification** Timeline.

## F. REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUOTA PLACES

#### **REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUALIFICATION PLACES**





Any allocated quota places that are returned/not confirmed by an NOC will be reallocated to the next best ranked NOC not yet qualified from the Men's or Women's Junior Cup Nation Cup Score of the season 2018/2019 respectively. NOCs that are reallocated quotas can only receive a maximum of one (1) quota per gender per NOC.

#### REALLOCATION OF UNUSED HOST COUNTRY PLACES

If the Host Country qualifies through D.1 or D.2 or if it declines all of its Host Country quota places, then the next ranked NOC, not yet qualified according to D.1 or D.2 in the respective gender IBU Junior Cup Nation Cup Score of the season 2018/2019, will be allocated three (3) quota places.

If the Host Country returns some of its host country places, these returned quota places will be reallocated according to "Reallocation of Unused Qualification Places" section.
